Child performed #51 (“Skip It, Lou”) for their audience. Child should play it 3 times perfectly on their own BEFORE performing it for their audience. When practicing on their own, the child should speak the notes, speak and finger, and then play it.		
Child played with the correct notes and rhythms (to the best of your knowledge). We are working on 8 th notes!		
Child quietly tapped their foot (their toe or their heel) to a steady beat while playing.		
Child played with proper posture for their instrument: Standing or sitting on the edge of a chair, back straight, both feet flat on the floor, with correct hand position.		
Child accepted applause with grace, and thanked the audience for listening by bowing and smiling.
