Child followed along with the notes in their book as they played (do not let them play the song from memory). We are working on reading music, so this is important!		
Child played the correct notes and rhythms to the best of your knowledge. Child should be speaking the rests out loud (they should be saying “rest rest” or “rest 2 3 4”).		
Child played with proper posture for their instrument: Standing or sitting on the edge of a chair, back straight, both feet flat on the floor, with correct hand position.		
Child accepted applause with grace, and thanked the audience for listening by bowing and smiling.
