## Measure Assignments

**Flutes:** Measures 36 – 47 **and** 48 – the end

**Clarinets:** 46 – end (take the D.S. al Coda back to 9 and then the Coda!)

**Saxophones:** Measures 27 – 47 (with all of the dynamics!)

**Bassoon:** Measures 27 – 47

**Trumpets:** 48 – the end (Practice so you can play it FAST and accurately!)

**Trombones:** Measures 27 – 47

**Baritones:** Measures 27 – 47

**Tuba:** Measures 27 – 47

**Mallet Percussion:** Measures 36 – 47 **and** 48 – the end

**Bongos:** Measures 27 – 47 and 48 – the end (count your rests out loud)

**Timpani/Tambourine:** 27 – 47 (count your rests out loud)

**Snare Drum/Hi-Hat:** 27 – 47 (count your rests out loud)

**Bass Drum:** Measures 36 – 47 **and** 48 – the end

\*Percussionists: Since you don't have many of these instruments at home, play your rhythms on a drum pad or other household objects. Just make sure to play correct rhythms, dynamics, and accents!
