

# Performing Arts Summer Programs - 2019

**NAME OF PROGRAM:** Galvin Summer Honors Band

**STUDENTS INVOLVED:** 5th-8th grade band students in the 2018-19 school year

**PREREQUISITES (IF ANY):** At least one year of instruction on their current instrument unless approved by director

**DATES AND TIMES OF PROGRAM:** July 22-26 from 8-11:30am; Concert on July 26th at 12pm

**COST OF PROGRAM:** \$125.00 (includes tuition, camp t-shirt, and any additional materials)

**LOCATION OF PROGRAM:** Galvin Middle School

**DESCRIPTION OF PROGRAM:** This one week ensemble allows students to play in a fun, supportive, mixed level environment to keep up their "chops" and put the skills they have gained throughout the year to work performing styles of music not commonly seen in their ensembles during the school year, including movie music, pop, rock and/or jazz. With the assistance of a select group of high school music mentors, as well as other members of the Wakefield Music Faculty, students will work to prepare a performance both as a full ensemble and smaller instrument-specific sectionals. The honors band will be directed by Ms. Jenna DiMento, GMS band director.

**NAME OF PROGRAM:** Galvin Middle School Jazz Workshop

**STUDENTS INVOLVED:** 6th-8th grade band students in the 2018-19 school year

**PREREQUISITES (IF ANY):** At least one year of instruction on their current instrument unless approved by director

**DATES AND TIMES OF PROGRAM:** July 15-19 from 8:00-11:30; Concert on July 19th at 11am

**COST OF PROGRAM:** \$125.00 (includes tuition, camp t-shirt and any additional materials)

**LOCATION OF PROGRAM:** Galvin Middle School

**DESCRIPTION OF PROGRAM:** This is a one week program providing an opportunity to further instrumental music skills while studying the jazz genre. Jazz workshop is great way for first time students to explore jazz, and for veteran jazz band members to expand improvisation and ensemble playing skills. With the assistance of both professional staff and a select group of high school music mentors, students will learn in both the full ensemble and smaller instrument-specific sectionals. The jazz workshop will be run by Mr. Michael Morel, GMS Music Teacher.

**NAME OF PROGRAM:** Galvin Summer Honors Orchestra

**STUDENTS INVOLVED:** 5th-8th grade orchestra students in the 2018-19 school year

**PREREQUISITES (IF ANY):** At least one year of instruction on their current instrument unless approved by director

**DATES AND TIMES OF PROGRAM:** August 5-9 from 12:00-3:30; August 9- Concert at 3pm

**COST OF PROGRAM:** \$125.00 (includes tuition, camp t-shirt and any additional materials)

**LOCATION OF PROGRAM:** Galvin Middle School

**DESCRIPTION OF PROGRAM:** The Summer Honors Orchestra is an opportunity for students who have completed 5th-8th grade to play together over the summer. Students will play lighter/pop songs in an ensemble setting as well as receive instruction in a small group sectional setting. Participating students receive a camp tee shirt. The week concludes with a performance for family and friends. The orchestra will be run by Ms. Sarah Bowen, GMS Music Teacher.

**NAME OF PROGRAM:** Galvin Middle School A Cappella Workshop

**STUDENTS INVOLVED:** 6th-8th grade choral students in the 2018-19 school year

**DATES AND TIMES OF PROGRAM:** August 12-16 from 12:00-3:30; August 16 Concert at 3pm

**COST OF PROGRAM:** \$125.00 (includes tuition, camp t-shirt, and any additional materials)

**LOCATION OF PROGRAM:** Galvin Middle School

**DESCRIPTION OF PROGRAM:** This is a one week program providing an opportunity to further vocal music skills while studying the contemporary a cappella genre. The A Cappella Workshop will give students the opportunity to work on solo singing, vocal percussion, choreography, mic technique, and improvisation, while being assisted by both professional staff and a select group of high school music mentors. The a cappella workshop will be run by Mrs. Ana Morel, WHS Chorus Teacher and Mr. Kieran Reilly, GMS Chorus Teacher.

**NAME OF PROGRAM:** Summer Music Jam! (2-4 Summer Music Camp)

**STUDENTS INVOLVED:** Students entering grades 3-5 (completed grades 2-4)

**DATES AND TIMES OF PROGRAM:** July 29-Aug. 2 from 8:30-11:30; August 2- Showcase at 11:00

**COST OF PROGRAM:** \$125.00 (includes tuition, 2019 Camp T-Shirt, "Musical Goodie Bag," a recording of their own music-making, and any additional materials)

**LOCATION OF PROGRAM:** Galvin Middle School

**DESCRIPTION OF PROGRAM:** "Summer Music Jam!" is a fun, fast-paced environment where students will learn and make music together and have tons of fun doing it! Activities will include: world drumming, percussion jam bands with instruments, games designed for development in music literacy, vocal development activities, movement games, and folk dancing.
